

## Volunteer Bays & Other general info – the New Peterborough City Hospital

The latest info is below. Please add your own experiences to this information. We have maps of the Hospital in the office and a few spare copies

### **Disabled Parking – disabled badge only**

**IF YOUR PASSENGER** has a disabled badge, there are disabled bays

- Directly in front of the main entrance (and where the volunteer bays **used** to be)
- Car park A (women and children's unit)
- Car park F (haematology/ oncology)
- Car park G – this can be found by driving past the main entrance and to the rear of the building. Car park G is directly next to car park F (haematology/ oncology).

IF (and hopefully you won't need to) you have to go into a car park, disabled passengers can get their ticket validated at the Main Reception, women and children's unit or haematology & oncology unit (on production of their disabled badges) to get out free of charge. **After reception you still need to go to the ticket machine – it just will not charge you!**

You can also get your ticket validated to get out of the Car Parks free on production of your **VA badge(s) as well, remember to go to the ticket machine as well.**

### **Drop off Zone**

20 yards past the main entrance is a drop off zone.

### **Volunteer Bays – 6 left**

Head left towards Car Park F. Do **not** go through the barrier into the Car Park but adjacent to the entrance to F there are 6 spaces. (It is near the Dept of Sexual Health). Display your badges as usual.

Rather than walk outside back to the main entrance, you can (unofficially) from this area go through the Oncology unit entrance and this can then lead either back to the atrium or follow signs to the department you want. Getting back out this way, remember to follow signs to the Oncology UNIT not the wards.

You may of course meet with your passengers at the front entrance and go and get the car, as this could be too long a walk for a number of them.

- For Physio you need Rehabilitation,
- Need to allow an **extra 10 minutes** at peak times. (including 8am when all the staff are arriving).
- There are 2 coffee bars, so if you are meeting there **MAKE SURE YOU SAY WHICH ONE!**
